- Perform only those activities assigned or permitted by the teacher. "Activities" include using materials, equipment, tools, computers and other devices; conducting experiments; completing projects, or anything else in the STEM room.
- → All materials and equipment should be treated with care and respect.
- → Safety goggles, aprons, gloves, or other equipment may be required for certain activities. If you are required to wear any safety equipment, you must keep it on.
- → Immediately report an accident, mishandling, injury, or unsafe condition to the teacher, no matter how minor it may appear.
